School Dress Code

After consultation with the school community, including parents, students and staff, the North Woodvale Primary School Board has established a dress code for all students attending the school. The code is also strongly supported by the P&C Association.

The community of North Woodvale Primary School believes a dress code:

- Inspires a sense of identity and pride in self, school and community
- Fosters and enhances the public image of the school
- Assists in building school team spirit
- Encourages equity among students
- Ensures students are safely dressed for specific school activities and are easily identified when on excursions
- Is fair and reasonable by contemporary standards

Dress Code Requirements

- School Colours and red and navy blue
- School polo shirt with school logo
- School windcheater-zip front with school logo
- Navy blue shorts, unisex style or cargo style
- Navy blue track pants
- Navy blue skirt
- Navy blue stockings, tights or leggings
- Plain coloured crew length socks
- Navy blue broad brimmed hat
- Navy blue scarf

If not purchasing a school uniform, then uniform colours must be plain (no logos or signs)

Year 6 Graduation Uniform

A graduation shirt (with students' names listed on the back- school logo on the front) is available to be purchased. This becomes an alternative uniform on certain days of the week.

Faction Colours

Students may wear their faction athletics shirt on their timetabled Physical Education class and sports day.

Please Note

- Hair longer than shoulder length must be tied back (all students)
- No make-up, nail polish or jewellery except for a watch (smart watches are discouraged and may not be used for any form of communication)
- Earring studs only-note required if for medical reasons, sleepers need to be worn



Shoes

Sneakers, trainers or closed in shoes are required to be worn daily

Hats

The school has a NO HAT-NO PLAY policy. Students are required to have a navy blue broad brimmed hat at school at all times.

Non-Compliance

Where students do not follow the dress code:

- They will be reminded of dress code requirements by a designated staff member
- Parents will be notified
- Assistance/support will be provided if necessary

Note: Students failing to follow dress code requirements may be excluded from excursions, visits, or extra curricula activities. Repeated non-compliance may be considered as a serious breach of the school's Behaviour Management Policy and incur sanctions as outlined in that policy.
